

# Black Knights Spring Thaw Bowhunter Trail Shoot

April 22, 8am-3pm



Join us at the Nye Holeman State Archery Range,  
South River Rd., Tolland, CT,

It's like a 3-D shoot, but we use **OnCore 2-D Targets**, mounted on the **large target houses** of this beautiful, **easy to walk course!** **All distances are known**, and 12-rings are painted for easy aiming. You get challenging shots, with a **very low chance for lost arrows!** There are 15 targets, 2 arrows are shot at each target, for a total of 30 arrows.

The following divisions will be recognized:

(Men and women compete in separate divisions. Awards will be given based on the "unit rule")  
(Registration in multiple divisions is permitted)

**Bowhunter-** Max distance 40 yards- Any bow, fingers or release, any single or multi-pin sight (no scopes), arrows must have removable field points, max 12" stabilizer. (In other words, any hunting set-up)

**Traditional-** Max distance 30 yards- Any recurve or longbow, no sights, no plungers, no stabilizers, no slings

**Open-** Max distance 60 yards- Any bow, fingers or release, any sight, including scopes, no stabilizer restrictions, target points may be used. (In other words, any target archery set-up)

**Archers in the Open Division may choose to enter the "pot shoot" for an additional \$20.**

**100% of the pot will be paid back to the winning archers, based on the unit rule.**

**Young Adult-** Max Distance 30 yards- Archers ages 15-17. Recurve and compound bows compete in separate divisions

**Youth-** Max distance 30 yards- Archers ages 12-14. Recurve and compound bows compete in separate divisions

**Cub-** Max Distance 20 yards- Archers ages 11 and under. Recurve and compound bows compete in separate divisions.

Registration opens at 8am each day.

Shooting must be completed, and scorecards turned in, by 3pm.

Shooting fee is \$15/archer for adults, \$5/archer for all kids divisions.
