



Archery Classes

Classes are offered for students of all experience levels, from beginners to seasoned tournament archers, ages 8 and up. Equipment is provided, or bring your own. The instructor, William Hall, is a multiple time National Championship medalist, with over 20 years of coaching experience.

Beginner Program- (60 min per class) This program is designed for those with little to no formal archery training. The 10 weeks of the program are a structured walk through all of the essential basics of the sport, including, but not limited to; Range Safety, Proper Shooting Form, How the Bow Works, Grouping and Sight Adjustment and Scoring.

Advanced Program- (60 min per class) For those students who have completed the KFAP beginner program, the Advanced Program focuses more on individual coaching, goal setting, mental training, and continued advancement through the KFAP Ranking and Award System. (Those with significant formal training, who have not taken classes with KFAP, may seek an exemption from the instructor to join the advanced class, by scheduling a private, evaluation session. Outdoor Tournament Program – (90 minutes per class) This program, held at the Nye Holeman Range, is specifically designed for those with a desire to take part in outdoor archery tournaments. Students must have their own equipment (additional equipment/upgrades may be required) and minimum scoring requirements apply (requirements vary with age). We will shoot a mixture of target and field archery, and cover many topics pertaining to successful outdoor shooting. Students that take this class are required to participate in at least one outdoor tournament; the Black Knights Field Shoot (June 10), the CAA 600 (June 30 or July 1), and/or the CAA Field Shoot (July 14 or 15)
